

**A Hands-Free Federal law is needed:**

Virtually all of the European countries, Canada, and Australia have vehicle crash and fatality rates that are more than half those in the US. One big difference is that all of these countries have laws in place that ban the use of HH phones while driving, In addition, virtually any activity that requires the use of the driver's eyes or hands is prohibited (for example manual entry of the GPS destination address). In the US, only 11 states have HH bans in place. This suggests that the way for the US to significantly reduce vehicle crash and fatality rates is to enact a HH ban at the federal level.
